Dear Campers and Parents,

As summer approaches it will soon be time for the 2010 Greenbrier Baptist Youth Camp. This camp is designed to provide the best Christian experience possible. Our goal is that every camper age 11-24 will have the opportunity to develop a deeper and more meaningful experience in Jesus Christ. Camp will be held July 11-17 at the Summers County 4-H Camp. Registration will be from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. on the dining hall patio. **Please do not come to the campground before 4:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon.** Camp will be dismissed at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday July 17. Please make arrangements to have campers picked up at this time. **The cost of camp this year will be \$125.00. Please make all checks payable to Greenbrier Baptist Youth Camp.**

We hope you are planning to come to camp this year and will pray for our camp leaders as plans are made for our 2010 camp. Don't forget to bring your KJV BIBLE to camp. Your clothing should be informal camp clothes. It would be a good idea to bring a jacket, raincoat, umbrella, flashlight and hiking shoes. Athletic clothing, shoes, cleats, and a softball glove may also be needed if you are interested in playing sports. Dresses will not be required at the evening service, but if worn must be knee length. Guidelines for dress are listed on the back under rules 5-9. You will also need personal toiletry items such as soap, shampoo, toothbrush, towels, bed linens, pillow and a sleeping bag or blanket. The camper is responsible for any items brought to camp including money.

There will be a camp bank located in the camp store. All money should be deposited in the camp bank when you register. Campers may withdraw money daily at the camp store. The camp store carries various types of soft drinks, chips, candy bars etc.

If you have medications to bring with you to camp, please give them to our camp nurse who is on staff with us all week. She will take care of daily dispersions of medications.

On the other side of this letter is a copy of the camp rules and a registration form. Please read all of the camp rules, fill in all blanks of the registration form and bring it with you when you register on July 11. I also hope that you will give additional copies of this registration form to all your friends and encourage them to come to camp.
